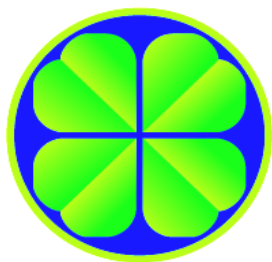

With sadness, we have decided to withdraw from The Big Sing! event.

Unfortunately, the organisers have had to change the venue for the event, and rather than being in Norwich City Football Club stadium, it will now take place at Norwich Showground. Whereas the initial venue offered shelter from hot or wet weather and staged seating to provide the children with a good view of all that was going on, that is clearly not the case with the showground. As coaches for 110 children plus accompanying staff would have cost £600+, I have decided that the new arrangement does not justify the large cost.

We are sorry for the disappointment this will cause and have decided to dedicate the afternoon of 3rd May to show-casing the work that children have been doing in poetry, dance and singing (including songs from The Big Sing!)
