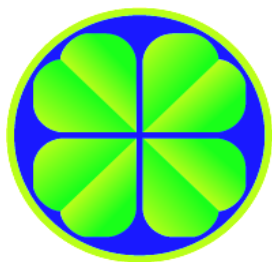

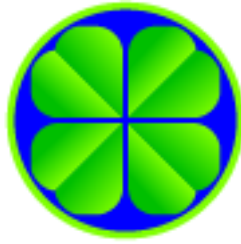
## Exemplar Education Letter
