**Pupil Premium Strategy for 2016-17**

The number of children who qualify for Pupil Premium at Preston CE VC Primary School is very small in comparison with the National average.

Funding for 2016-17 is £11740

Objectives:

1. Children should be, and feel, included in all areas of school life, regardless of background, home circumstance or financial situation.
2. Children should be supported in achieving their full personal, social and academic potential; barriers must be identified and additional support provided as appropriate
3. Children should be supported in developing and maintaining high self-esteem and be encouraged in their aspirations

The barriers we have identified this year are very specific to individual children.

Our plan for expenditure is:

- 1:1 tuition in English and Maths
- Small group support in class, provided by teaching assistants, for core subjects.
- Support for emotional health and wellbeing, including staff training.
- Financial support for residential trips, enrichment activities and instrumental tuition.
