Sport Premium Report for 2015-16

Funding for 2015-16 was £8415

Objectives:

- All children will receive high quality sports/PE provision during curriculum time
- All children will have the opportunity to access individual and team sports and activities through an extra-curricular programme
- Children will have the opportunity to compete at cluster level and to qualify for tournaments at a higher level
- Children will develop a healthy attitude towards competition and be positive about developing skills for the future

In order to meet our objectives, funding in 2015-16 was used in the following ways:

- Staff training
- Increased hours for support staff qualified to teach PE - for lessons and team coaching
- Contribution to salary of cluster sports coordinator
- Appointment of a sports competition coordinator within our PE team
- Cost of cover staff to release those accompanying children to off-site sports activities
- Travel
- Bought in extra-curricular sports clubs
- Subsidising trips and visits with a main focus on physical activity

Outcomes:

- The vast majority of children enjoy sport and PE lessons
- Lessons are well planned, delivered and evaluated
- Children make good progress in their development of physical skills
- Many children choose to attend clubs that focus on physical activities
- Many children in KS2 have represented the school in competitive sport
- Children are committed to training for events and want to succeed
- The school has been represented at a large percentage of cluster and local events

- School performance in competition in 2015-16 was very strong; the school qualified for South Norfolk finals in Cross Country; Tag Rugby, Kwik Cricket and Football.
- School teams were represented in the Norfolk School Games finals in cross country and football.
- Parental support for sports events is strong
