

Tasburgh Scarecrow Trail 2016

Rules and Guidelines

The Competition and Trail starts midday on Friday 23rd September and runs until 6pm on Friday 30th September 2016. Scarecrows need to be visible each day of the trail from 9am to 6pm.

Entrants should do their best to maintain their scarecrow in good condition throughout the trail period. It is recommended that scarecrows in the front garden of private houses are set back from their front boundary fences to minimise the risk of vandalism.

If you wish to restrict access to your property, please put up a notice to that effect at the front boundary of your property.

(People following the trail are unlikely to pass through gates but may well walk up open driveways).

The organisers will provide a laminated poster that **must be** displayed with your scarecrow, and in easy view of the trail followers.

The organisers will take photographs of all of the registered scarecrows during the trail. Registration of a scarecrow permits the trail organisers to use these photographs on the School website and in future promotions.

Luxury Hampers will be awarded to the best 3 scarecrows as voted for by the public taking part in the trail. All winners will also receive a certificate.

An awards ceremony will be held on Saturday 1st October, more details to follow.

All Scarecrow entrants will be given a laminated poster to display next to their scarecrow before the trail commences with their Scarecrow unique number and Trail code letter.
