Guide to Using Active Learn: Grammar and Spelling

Your child may be set different activities to complete at home. This guide gives you some brief information on how to use the Grammar and Spelling activities.

When opening 'My Stuff' in Active Learn, it will show the Abacus Maths activities as it always has (see separate guidance for this). However, you now will see other icons:



Within the Grammar and Spelling section, there will be a selection of activities.

Each activity will have a short video to watch then some games and activities to try.

Children are encouraged to keep trying until they have got all of the questions correct but can go back at another time to complete it.

Click on a unit to open it:



Within a unit, you can:

- Click on the **“Play”** icon in the TV screen to watch a video about the unit
- Click on the **“i” information button** beside each game to see what it is about
- Click on the **game buttons** to play the games
- Click **“Finish”** once you have played all the games, to complete the unit
- In Year 1 and Year 2, you can click on the **audio speaker button** to listen to instructions.

You can look in the home learning area of our school website (a link can be found [here](#)), for a glossary to help with terms (one for pupils and one for teachers if you would like a little more detail). Within each year group section, you will also find notes on the particular elements your child has been allocated.

The aim is for your child to tackle this independently but you may find the notes useful.
