

# Using Discovery Espresso

Discovery espresso can be used on a tablet or on a pc. Some functions do not work on a tablet. Discovery espresso works better through Chrome  than through Explorer. 

1. Go to [www.discoveryeducation.co.uk](http://www.discoveryeducation.co.uk)
2. Click on **LOGIN** and select **Espresso**
3. Enter the username: **student23641**
4. Enter the password: **preston**

This screen may appear. If it does, click on the grey box

5. You will be brought to the home page from where you can navigate to a wide range of resources.



6. At any point, clicking the home symbol or the word Home will return you to the home screen.



7. The **Foundation**, **Key Stage 1** and **Key Stage 2** tabs navigate to resources aimed at those children.



Foundation – Reception  
 Key Stage 1 – Years 1 and 2  
 Key Stage 2 – Years 3 to 6

If you **hover** the cursor over the phase you want, you will get a drop down menu.

If you **click** on the phase tab, it will look more like this.



You will see the same headings appear. You can navigate in either way.


8. **EYFS** resources are divided into seven learning areas. You click on the area you need and follow the given thread.

## PHONICS

1. Click on **Foundation**
2. Scroll down to and click on **Phonics**



3. The screen will then look like this.



4. Select the phase that your child is on.

Your child will most likely know which sounds they have covered in school. If they are unsure, begin on **Scrap's Phonics** and work your way from there.

We use this resource with the children in school. By clicking on a chosen sound, you will be able to access a video. This video will demonstrate how to pronounce and write each sound. It will also provide you with some words which include the sound. Use this video to practise sounds that your child has already learnt and to learn new sounds that may come up in their reading. **We would highly recommend learning each sound in the order they are in rather than selecting sounds randomly.**

5. If you select **Activities**, you will discover a range of games to play.

6. By clicking on **Module Guide**, you will find information about how best to support your child with phonics.
