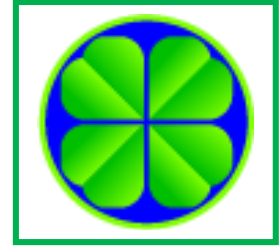

## **Home Learning – Fortnight 5**

Dear Parents and Carers,

### Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 who are not in school / are keyworker children

For English and Maths, we will continue to use Active Learn to allocate activities. Additional resources will be distributed via Class Notebook. (Please remember that these are extra resources and do not need to be printed out.) These will include the topic for this fortnight which is 'Science Explorers'. A copy of the topic resources can also be found on the school website.

### Children in Years 2, 3, 4 and 5

As you will know from the email you received on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June, your child will have an English and Maths timetable uploaded to a page on OneNote. This timetable will provide links to other resources and will make reference to pages in their workbooks. Some of the resources referred to in the timetables will be uploaded to OneNote too, along with the topic for this fortnight - 'Science Explorers'. There is no expectation that you follow the timetables provided; you may already have a routine for learning that works for you. You might wish to dip into the timetables and select activities to complete on different days. Do what works best for you and your child.

The workbooks belong to your child so they can write in them. You will be pleased to know that there are answers at the back.

We will continue to allocate reading books to your child via Bug Club on Active Learn and we will look to update these each week.

As the children in Years 2 to 5 are not able to return to school at the moment, we would like to provide them with the opportunity to have feedback on any work they complete. Any work that they wish us to see, should be uploaded on to a page within the 'homework' section of their OneNote account.

As we have part-time teachers in both schools and teachers teaching children in year groups that are different to their own, we are unable to provide instant feedback. Teachers

will look at the OneNote accounts on a weekly basis so it may be a few days before a teacher responds to your child's work.

If you are unable to access OneNote, please let us know by sending us an email.

Please continue to consider online safety and to have regular discussions with your child(ren). Both school websites have further information about e-safety.
