

UNIFORM

Although we are having to adapt to different circumstances at school this year, our general uniform rules remain in place.

Due to the need to ventilate rooms, the children may need an additional layer - in addition to their uniform. Any additional warm layers should be plain and in a sober colour - black, grey, dark green, navy, burgundy etc. would all be acceptable. They should not be decorated with pictures/ slogans etc.

Children are also permitted to wear a plain short scarf or snood and plain-coloured fingerless gloves in the classroom, if the weather becomes colder.

Some of our older children continue to attend with short trousers or skirts with bare legs - and then say they feel cold! Please ensure your child attends school in uniform matched to the temperatures they will experience in school during the day.

Hairbands - please note that novelty hairbands, for example those with pom poms or 'ears', are not part of school uniform.

Nail Polish is not part of the school uniform and we ask that is removed for school.
