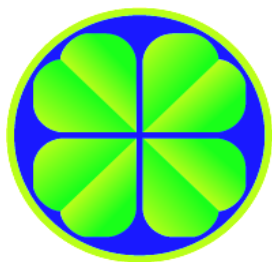

Reporting Sickness and Absence

Covid

You should have received the Covid Symptom Checker by email last week.

You are no longer required to inform us if someone in your household tests positive for Covid but we would find it helpful to know if they do.

Uniform

PE
