- looking at the features of basic lifecycles

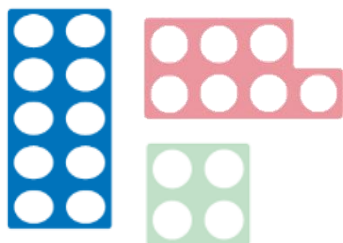
Maths

This half term we will be looking at:

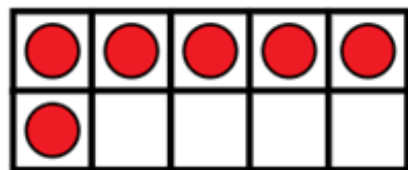
- sorting objects based on attributes such as colour, size, and shape

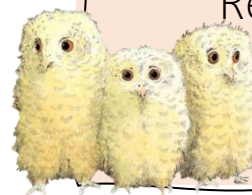

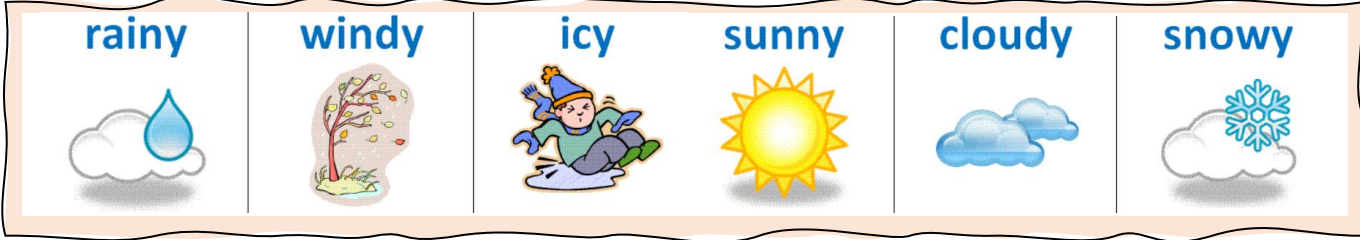

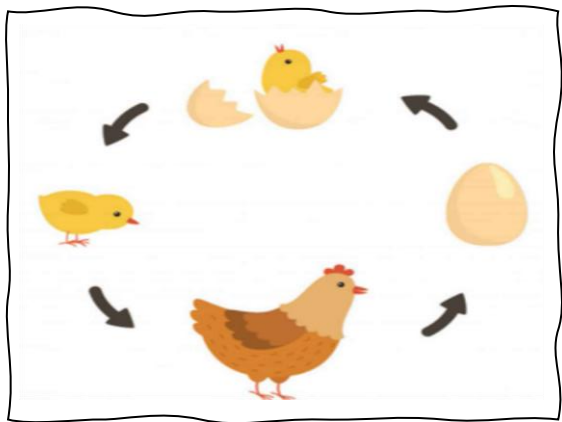
